Question 5: What else did God create?

Answer: God created all things and all his creation was very good.

Genesis 1:31

Do not share the question and answer until the end of this exercise!

For little ones: go through the alphabet and ask them to think of one thing that God created for each letter of the alphabet.

For older ones – Play a version of Scattegories. Give everyone a piece of paper. Write the alphabet down the Left side of the page. Set a timer and have each member of your family write something God created for each letter of the alphabet. When the time is up, share what everyone wrote.

Now share question 5 above and ask your family to guess what the answer is. Then share and memorize the answer above.

Read Genesis 1:31. What does God tell us about what he has made?

What is one of your favorite things that God has made?

Pray and thank God for what he has made and how he has made it.

For further study and thinking: Something happened after God created everything and pronounced it all “good” that damaged everything God has made (see Genesis 3:17-19). Is everything God has created still good? Why or why not? (see 1 Timothy 4:4-5).
